## Our Workshops

Base

Positive, hands-on, non-technical workshops that engage and inspire your people for a resource-light (work)life and society!

#### 1. Waste Rebels

Minimal Waste Workshop; getting hands-on with mini-workshops for a low waste society

3 hours

#### 2. Foodwaste Heroes

Preparing a surprising foodwaste recipe while learning about food and foodwaste

#### 3. Plogging

A fun Cleanup Workshop in small groups, with an input about waste and getting to a low-waste society

The ultimate mobility game and journey into slower and alternative forms of moving

- → All workshops are interactive and feature hands-on activities, plus where possible and desired also mini-excursions or physical activity.
- → A workshop can be shortened; for example to 90 minutes.





- A workshop can be customised to your goals and needs.
- Prizes depend on the number of people and the nature of the organisation, plus the amount of customisation.

#### **1. Waste Rebels** - DoltYourself minimal waste workshops



Participants gain insights into the potential of minimal-waste lifestyles with short and fun DoitYourself (DiY) workshops, such as making deodorant or cleaning spray, plus a range of inspiring examples of how you can reuse and reduce. We furthermore bring a variety of products and recipes for inspiration.

Outcome: One or more products to take away, plus tools to avoid waste and think circularly in everyday (work) life.

### **2. Food Waste Heroes** – a food and foodwaste workshop with a yummy "leftover" recipe to enjoy

Food is the answer to many sustainability challenges, and also a source of great pleasure. We will look at the how, prepare end enjoy a recipe together with "wasted" food, and share knowledge about it over a quiz.

Outcome: Team building in a relaxed social setting, while building awareness of the big food waste challenge we face as a society and at home.



#### **3. Plogging** – actively changing your environment!



Littering is not just an aesthetic problem; diverse toxics land in soil and especially waters. A factual danger to animals and ... people. During a cleanup we will help tackle this problem and also look at how we can move toward a "less-waste" society! Each plogging takes about 3 hours with breaks. If that is not possible, we can of course shorten the workshop.

Outcome: A fun and meaningful outdoor activity for small and larger teams, that includes concrete inputs about how to act for a lower-waste society.

#### 4. Travel Challenge - the ultimate mobility game



In the first part we play our sustainable travel memory game in a way that you would sit together in a train (not a plane or a car!) and we'll look at Europe's train routes. This encourages people to consider the alternatives there are for travel within and for the organisation. In the second part we'll go out if possible and do a fun tour.

#### Outcome: Individual- and company-wide ideas to reduce travel and find greener mobility alternatives.

## Workshops Plus

**Custom!** We have invented many workshop concepts and are the masters of positive, interactive concepts that have impact for people and planet. We are really happy to create a custom offer, based on your needs and interests. We can also create a full-day programme in which we combine the previously mentioned workshops, swapping groups over lunch, for example.

#### If you want a workshop that concretely aims to support sustainability on the workfloor, these are 2 options:

- 1. **PopUp-Store:** This co-creation activity allows people to discover the benefits of a Sharing Economy by creating an internal shared marketplace.
- 2. Less = More @Work: A fun workshop to set challenges and come up with concrete measures at the workfloor / in the organisation.

#### **PopUp-Store** - creating a sharing economy



Creating a sharing economy together. Having people experience how easy it can be to share—not only our personal resources—but also those of the company.

We will create a pop-up store that could also give rise to longer-term projects; one of which could be a company resource-sharing "map."

Outcome: Participants value physical resources more and think ahead (towards a circular company and economy). Also promotes interaction between all organisational departments!

#### Less = More @Work

An interactive co-creation workshop which starts with a lucky-wheel and ends up with specific plans and actions for your department or the organisation as a while.

Outcome: A more sustainable workspace and momentum for further improvements that create a win-win for all.
